## **2B Accountability of the Chief Executive Officer**

The Chief Executive Officer is the Board's only link to operational achievement and conduct, so that all authority and accountability of staff, as far as the Board is concerned, is considered the authority and accountability of the Chief Executive Officer.

1. The Board will never give instructions to persons who report directly or indirectly to the Chief Executive Officer.
2. The Board will refrain from formally or informally evaluating any staff other than the Chief Executive Officer, but may, in evaluating the CEO, take into account the performance of the Vice Presidents.
3. The Board will view Chief Executive Officer performance as identical to organizational performance so that organization accomplishment of Board-stated Ends within Executive Limitations will be viewed as successful Chief Executive Officer performance.
